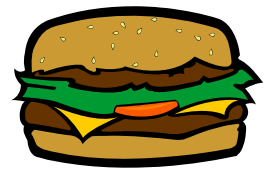
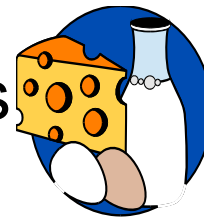


Cline's Class News

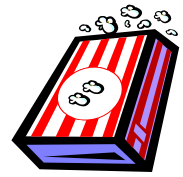

We started our nutrition unit this week. We talked about the 5-food groups: Grain group, fruit group, vegetable group, dairy/milk group and meat/protein group. We also learned about the fats. We did many activities figuring out what foods go in each group. Ask your child to sing the food pyramid chant!! They had a good time singing it. We discussed food that was healthy and unhealthy for our bodies. Thank you to all that turned in their homework that pertained to unhealthy and healthy foods. The children had fun sharing these with the class.☺ One of the other things we discussed is what happens on a Dairy Farm. Ask your child how the process goes from the milk going from the farm to the store.

In writing this week, we wrote directions on how to make a peanut butter and jelly sandwich. We discussed the importance of giving each detail, and what could happen if we left something out. We will continue to write directions on how to make something or do something.

Next week we will begin our Plants and Seeds unit. We will learn about the things plants need to grow, the parts of a plant, and the sequence of how plants grow from seed to plant. We will also grow our own grass and our own lima bean plants.
