This week we focused on reviewing sight words and math concepts. One goofy review game the children enjoyed was "erase a face" where they could draw a silly face and then erase one part each time they said a sight word correctly.

In science we focused on the parts of plants, what they need to survive, and what soil is.

For read aloud we read The House in the Meadow, Corduroy, Corduroy's Garden, and The Tiny Seed. The students practiced retelling with Corduroy dolls they made.

For centers the students used dice and stampers to "give Corduroy buttons". They made their names and
